PROJECT	MAXIMUM GRANT
<b>Clean Water Diversion</b> - Berms and eavestroughs to divert clean water from manure and exercise yards.	\$3,000
<b>Erosion Control Measures</b> - Grassed waterways, catch basins, terraces and berms to reduce erosion.	\$3,000
<b>Fragile Land Retirement</b> - Planting trees and shrubs on erosion-prone land. Buffer strips along watercourses.	\$2,000
<b>Livestock Fencing</b> - Fences, crossings and watering devices to eliminate watercourse livestock access.	\$3,000
<b>Wellhead Protection</b> - Pitless adapter caps, grading, sealing and upgrading well casings to prevent contamination.	\$500
<b>Well Decommissioning</b> - Properly decommissioning abandoned wells to eliminate the link between surface and ground water.	\$500
<b>Community Projects</b> - Stewardship and educational projects by community groups.	\$3,000
