### **Huronview Demonstration Farm Hosts Studies**

One study and possibly another are helping the Huron County Soil and Crop Improvement Association (HSCIA) demonstrate agricultural practices Huronview the demonstration farm south of Clinton.

The first study involves collaboration between Ausable **Bayfield** Conservation, Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada, and the University of Guelph. Researchers will be investigating whether electrical conductivity can serve as a surrogate metric for site-specific measures for soil health. This will allow for a better understanding about

soil health and allow individual producers to compare their numbers to meaningful benchmarks.

If successful in obtaining funding, the HSCIA will investigate controlled drainage. Adding structures at tile headers can allow drainage systems to be 'turned off', which subsequently causes a

back up of water in the tile system and allows for subsurface irrigation. Although controlled drainage is not a new technology, the Huronview project aims to make it work on slopes.
