The successful candidate will assist the Stewardship and Conservation Lands Department in a variety of tasks relating to stewardship programs of the Conservation Authority.

The successful candidate will assist in the development and implementation of conservation services programs within the watershed. Duties may include:

- Outreach initiatives for landowners to promote the protection, enhancement, and rehabilitation of creeks, streams, and natural features.
- Helping landowners develop and implement stewardship projects for water quality, soil conservation, wetlands and fish and wildlife habitat.
- Ecological restoration projects through the Authority's tree planting program.
- Working with ABCA staff to implement stewardship projects on ABCA properties.

Knowledge of database software such as Excel and Access may be required.

GIS would be an asset.

The successful candidate must be willing to work outdoors and in adverse environmental conditions.

Good computer skills as well as written and oral communication skills are required.

A valid driver's licence is also required.
