## Cover Crop Boost Program 2021 Project Requirements

Performance Incentive: \$30/acre for a cover crop

Maximum Payment: \$3,000 (maximum 100 acres per applicant)

#### Purpose:

- 1. This program will encourage growers to try cover crops and techniques and help demonstrate their use.
- 2. To promote the establishment and over-wintering of cover crops (living or dead), which help provide soil protection and reduce soil erosion to watercourses.
- 3. To protect groundwater by promoting biological nitrogen capture.

#### **Details:**

- 1. Restricted to landowners planting cover crops in the Bayfield, Bayfield North, or South Gullies watersheds.
- 2. Cover crop can be one or more species (may be combined with Huron Clean Water funding, as long as HCW requirements and approval are met).
- 3. Applicants must register their eligible fields with ABCA staff, providing location and management plan for the cover crop.
- 4. Crops may be tilled no sooner than the spring of the year following planting (may be chemically killed the previous fall).
- 5. Applicants must notify staff well before spring tillage so the final crop residue measurement can be made.
- 6. A final residue measurement of at least 50% is required prior to planting the next crop in the following spring.
- 7. Cover crop residue will be measures prior to April 1, establishing a firm spring deadline for measurements of success, and achieving the goal of ensuring over-winter cover.
- 8. Cover crops are not to be used for forage or grazing. The project is not eligible for funding if the field is grazed or harvested.
- 9. Applications for less than 25 acres (approximately 10 ha) will be subject to the discretion of the Review Committee.

#### Performance Incentive:

- 1. Applicants will be paid the incentive after ABCA staff has confirmed the field(s) were managed according to the guidelines.
- 2. Applicants do not have to produce proof of payment for cover crop seed.
- 3. Applicants who grow their own seed are eligible to participate in the program.
