Have a Safe Visit

CAUTION: This is a recreational nature trail for hiking. Surfaces may be slippery or uneven.

- Wear appropriate clothing, footwear and equipment for your trail activity.
- Be careful near the water.
- Watch for Poison Ivy and ticks.

Open sunrise to sunset daily

Rules

These rules protect you and others. They are enforced by *Conservation Authorities Act* and *Trespass to Property Act*.

- Motorized vehicles, bicycles, horses, hunting, alcohol use, drone use, fires and camping are **not** permitted.
- Keep dogs on a leash and under control always and clean up after dog.
- Do not remove or damage plants, trees, wildlife, signs or structures.
- Stay on the trails and respect neighbouring landowners.
- Fishing is permitted following all applicable provincial laws.
- Do not litter. Put waste in provided container or take it home with you.
- Smoking permitted following all applicable Provincial laws.

About the Park

- In 1973, Ausable Bayfield Conservation started purchasing the land for this park.
- In the water of the Bayfield River, there are many types of fish (such as Rock Bass and Salmon), mussels, and Crayfish.
- This multi-use recreation park includes recreational hiking trail, playground, and pavilion with picnic tables.

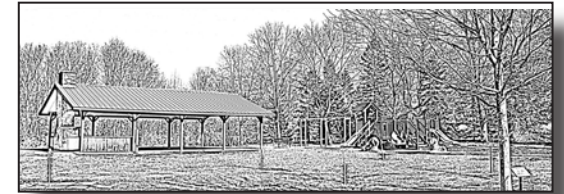

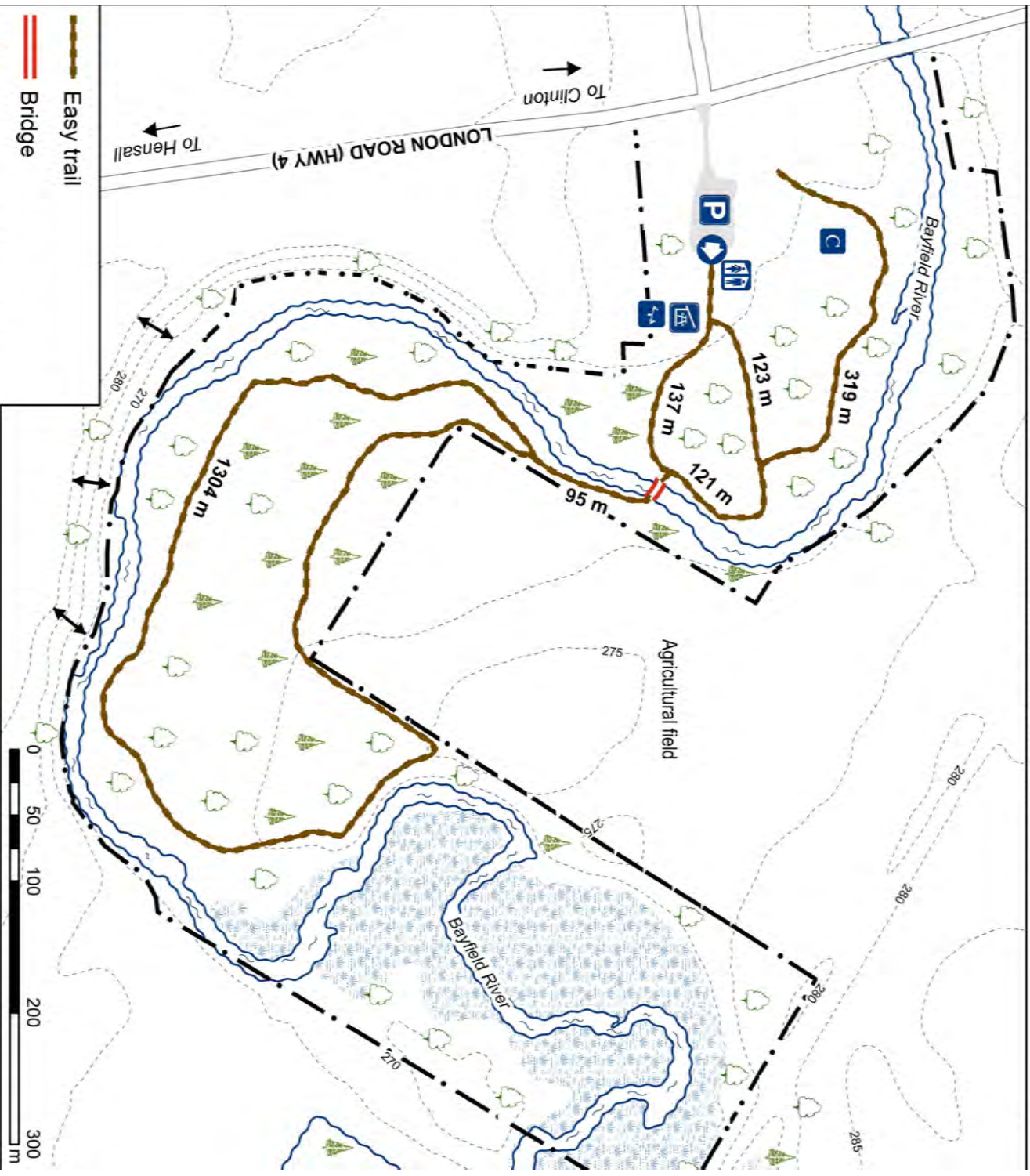
Recreational Trail Description

- **Distance:** 2 kilometre loop.
- **Difficulty:** Easy; families with children.
- **Trail Surface:** Natural surfaces: grass, dirt, and gravel.
- Trail subject to flooding. Use caution and avoid trails if water covered.
- The recreational trail follows part of the Bayfield River and takes about 45 minutes to hike the two-kilometre loop.
