

Snowshoe Rental Agreement

Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority



Terms of the Agreement:

1. Snowshoes will be picked up and dropped off by the user at the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority (ABCA) Administrative office to the Reception Area (71108 Morrison Line). Rental equipment may be picked up by users and transported to other locations within the Ausable Bayfield watershed. Typically, ABCA does NOT deliver or pick up equipment. Initial:
2. Knowledge of proper care and use of this equipment is required before the ABCA snowshoes are used. **Please read the snowshoe care and use information sheet.** We reserve the right to refuse rental if we feel that you are not prepared to use the equipment safely. Initial:
3. The renter will return snowshoes in the same condition in which they were received. The renter is responsible for any and all damages incurred beyond normal wear and tear. Renter must provide valid credit card in order to book snowshoes. In the event a snowshoe is damaged, lost, or stolen the ABCA will charge the credit card on file for a replacement set of the same or most similar snowshoes. Initial:
4. For those wishing to rent again during this winter season, it is understood that this agreement will be kept on file along with credit card information for the duration of the snowshoeing season. Initial:
5. **RECOGNITION OF RISK;** Renter expressly acknowledges that snowshoeing is an activity with inherent risks of injury to persons and property; Renter is aware of those risks and understands them. Renter alone has determined the sufficiency of any safety gear or other precautions that Renter decides to take to minimize the risks of the activity. No party related to Lessor, including Owner and Employees, has made any representations regarding the safety of, or the risks of, the activity. Renter expressly assumes the risks of the activity.
