

SPRING 2023 TREE PROGRAM

Trees and shrubs are available for purchase from Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority (ABCA) for conservation projects such as windbreaks, watercourse buffers and reforestation of erosion-prone slopes or marginal agricultural lands.

Funding is available to support many projects through federal, provincial and local cost-share programs. Field windbreaks, watercourse buffers and planting trees in larger blocks of a half acre or more may be eligible for funding. The location and type of project will determine its eligibility; projects ineligible for program funding will be responsible for the full cost. Please contact us for more information.

ABCA provides the following planting services for trees purchased from us: \$0.60 per seedling for machine planting and \$1.50 per seedling for hand planting \$0.30 per seedling for herbicide application around seedlings \$8.00 per tree for planting 2-foot ball and burlap conifers or potted deciduous \$15.00 per tree for 6-foot, bare-root deciduous trees \$0.60 per tree for herbicide application around large stock \$250 fee for preparation of a planting plan that includes administrative costs associated with grant applications and site supervision during planting

Planting services are available. There is no minimum project size; however a minimum fee of \$800 for planting and \$300 for herbicide treatment applies for our services.

to 50'	Organic (muck)/ Ioam	well to poorly drained	full sun	Tolerates wet soils, needles turn yellow in fall and drop, this is the native Larch.	
to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well to poorly drained	full sun	Good for moist sites but will also grow on upland sites with heavy clay soil; fast grower.	
to 80'	sand loam to clay	well-drained	Shade or sun	Important tree for timber and maple syrup production, requires protection from wildlife (rodents, rabbits and deer); slow grower.	
to 100'	sand/loam/clay	well-drained	full sun	Requires protection from wildlife; Oaks often recover from transplanting slowly but grow moderately fast once established.

- 1. Orders must be in multiples of 10 unless otherwise indicated. Minimum order is 100 seedlings or 20 large stock.
- 2. Orders not filled due to events beyond the ABCA's control will be refunded.
- 3. Customers must pick up trees at the ABCA Administration Office at the above address at scheduled times.
- 4. Customers are notified of pick-up times using the phone numbers provided below.
- 5. Trees purchased through this program are to be used for afforestation, windbreaks, erosion control and other stewardship projects, not landscaping.
- 6. Trees are not to be cut or otherwise removed from the planting area for a minimum of 15 years after planting.
- 7. The landowner agrees to provide protection from grazing, rodents and other damaging agents.
- 8. The ABCA takes all precaution to ensure the trees are received in the best possible condition. Due to environmental factors beyond our control, <u>WE DO NOT GUARANTEE SURVIVAL AFTER PLANTING</u>.
