The Wetland Technician assists the Healthy Watersheds Supervisor with implementing the Healthy Headwaters Wetland Initiative with wetland restoration and assisting with wetland mapping.

Duties may include:

- Assist with the construction, evaluation and mapping of wetlands
- Landowner contact and working with contractors
- Coordinating community outreach activities
- Proposal writing for wetland projects
- Field work identifying flora and fauna
- Wetland boundary delineation and vegetation community mapping

Qualifications:

- A University degree or a diploma from an accredited College in Biological or Environmental Science or Natural Resource Management
- Experience with restoration projects that improve water quality, aquatic habitat and healthy watersheds and with field assessments (wetland boundary confirmation, vegetation community mapping, flora and fauna inventory)
