The Assistant also assists with the preparation of material related to clearance letters for property transactions and with site inspections as required by the Authority's Planning & Regulations program.

The Assistant will also be required to perform data entry, research, edit and maintain the Authority's 'Planning & Regulations' database. Duties may also include map generation and summary report preparation. In addition to the required office duties, the successful candidate must be willing to work outdoors and in adverse environmental conditions.
