# **Grants Available for Tree Planting Projects**

Cost-share funding may be available for establishing field windbreaks, treed buffers, and other tree planting projects. Contact Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority (ABCA) Staff for more information. We will be happy to help with your project design and the grant application process.

# Plan Now for Spring 2018!

September and October are when site preparation should be done if you plan on planting trees next spring. ABCA staff members are available to help you with many aspects of land stewardship, including planting plans, site preparation, forest management plans and erosion control advice. Grants may cover up to 100% of the cost of reforestation projects.

## **Program Guidelines**

- 1. Customers must pick up their trees at the ABCA office during scheduled pick-up times. It is the customer's responsibility to provide accurate daytime contact information for notification of pick-up dates. No refunds will be given for orders not picked up.
- 2. Trees purchased through this program must be used for afforestation, windbreaks, and other stewardship projects, not for landscaping.
- 3. The ABCA takes no responsibility for the failure of stock provided, but will take all reasonable precautions to ensure the trees are received by the customer in the best possible condition.
- 4. The customer agrees to protect the trees from grazing, and wildlife damage, and not to harvest or remove trees from the planted area for a minimum of 15 years after planting.
- 5. The customer is responsible for complying with all municipal bylaws regarding tree planting, and for providing locates of any buried services in the planting area.
