

The Wander of Wetlands

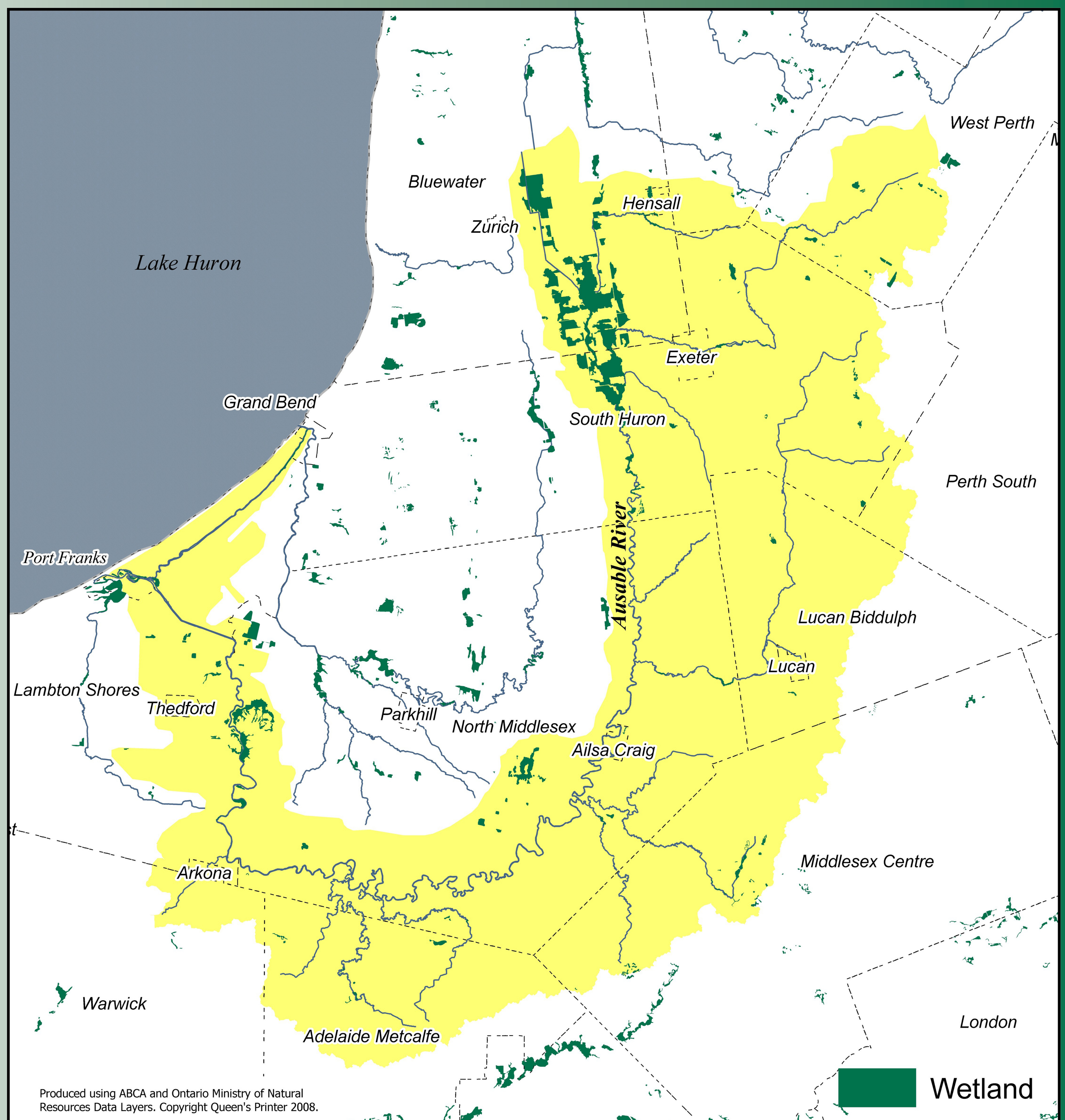


**Only two per cent of wetlands remain

What can you do to help conserve our local wetlands?

- In the spring, take note of where the wet areas persist and consider keeping water on the land to improve water quality by filtering sediment and nutrients
- Increase vegetation in wet areas and beside creeks with native plants
- Restrict livestock access from local waterways
- Remove garbage from wet areas
- Add nest boxes for waterfowl
- Express your interest in wetland conservation
- Participate in an Environmental Farm Plan (EFP) or Rural Stewardship Guide workshop and develop an Environmental Action Plan
- Monitor habitat for birds and frogs
- Visit local conservation areas
